

The Popping Wedge

The head is a foam cylinder sliced kitty corner at about 55 degrees. It is mounted on the hook so the face slants down at an angle to still pop, and dive briskly to a foot or so down. It then bobs up and crashes into the surface shaking its tail feathers and flashing at each change in direction. It pushes a lot of water when worked fast. Between popping noise and the pressure waves it pushes out will work very well in muddy and clear water. Note, this fly is good for Bass, Panfish, Trout, Tarpon, Bonefish, Pike, Musky and probably some more fish.

Hook: *Bass Style Hook in Various Sizes*

Tail: *Marabou and Flash or Krystal Flash*

Legs: *various colors, silicone legs*

Body: *Foam Cylinder*
